1.	Product Name	Shipping Guarantee-i (SG-i)		
2.	Type of Facility	Trade Bills-i Facility		
3.	What is SG-i?	A facility granted by the Bank to importers for the clearance of goods purchased at the port, without the original Bill of Lading (BL) being presented. The Bank will issue a Shipping Guarantee (SG-i) in favour of the Shipping Company/ agent to enable the customer (the importer, consignee or buyer) to take delivery of the merchandise.		
4.	Shariah Concept	Kafalah can be defined as a surety given by the first party who agrees to discharge a liability of a third party in case the second party defaults in fulfilling his obligation.		
5.	Conditions for Issuance of SG-i	 SG-i to be issued to customers whose documents are drawn under our Letter of Credit-i (LC-i). The application for the SG-i must be accompanied by the necessary forms for Trust Receipt (TR-i) or Accepted Bills (AB-i) and also Letter of Indemnity for Discrepancies. If the customer does not enjoy a TR-i/AB-i facility but documents are drawn under our LC-i, SG-i is to be issued against 100% deposit. The issuance of SG-i for documents not drawn under our LC-i or on collection basis is to be discouraged. 		
6.	Commission	 0.1% flat (minimum RM50.00) If the guarantee is not returned within 3 months from date of issuance, an additional commission of 0.5% per annum of the invoice amount shall be charged. 		
7.	Payment	 Shipping Guarantee-i is payable on demand where once SG-i is issued, the buyer is obligated to accept the document presented to him by the seller even there is discrepancy in the document. Total amount payable to the Bank is inclusive the fees and charges.
